About TCV:-

Following the Chinese occupation of Tibet in 1950 and His Holiness the Dalai Lama's flight to India, it was quickly apparent that one of the most critical needs of Tibetan refugees was finding a means to care for the many children who had been orphaned or separated from their families during the arduous escape from their homeland. His Holiness promptly recognized that the future of Tibet and its people depended upon the younger generation. With this in mind and out of concern for the miserable conditions under which so many children were suffering, His Holiness proposed that a centre for destitute children be established in Dharamsala.



➤ **Dharamsala:-**

Dharamsala stands at the foot of Dhauladhar and has a magnificent view of snowy peaks, deodar and pine forests, tea gardens and beautiful hills. The snow line is perhaps more easily accessible at Dharamsala than any other hill station in India. Dharamsala now really has become international, with a number of Tibetan settlements and the residence of Noble Laureate His Holiness 14th the 'Dalai Lama'. Dharamsala is divided into two distinct parts: lower Dharamsala the civil and business area with Courts and Kotwali bazar and upper Dharamsala composed of places like McLeod Ganj and Forsyth Ganj.

Dharamsala altitude is 1597 meters and varies from 1250 meters to 1600 meters. Dharamsala with its grand view of majestic Dhauladhar Mountain Range and beautiful surroundings has always been one of the favourite places to tourist not only from India.



◆ **When to visit:-**

- ▲ March to June
- ▲ September to November

◆ **How to get here:-**

- ▲ Air Route: - The nearest Airport is at Gaggal, 13 Kms from Dharamsala and 8 Kms from Kangra Town
- ▲ Train Route: - The nearest railway station is Pathankot which about 88 Km from Dharamsala, which is linked by direct trains to Amritsar, Delhi, Bombay and Calcutta.
- ▲ Overland Route: - Regular buses service is available from Pathankot to Dharamsala. There are also overland route from Manali to Dharamsala, Delhi to Dharamsala, Chandigarh to Dharamsala, Shimla to Dharamsala. Any other kind of transportation is easily available.

◆ **Trekking:-** Best time-March to June & October to November

- ▲ Snow – Lion Trek: - A moderate 2-3 days with Triund (2900m) and Snow Line (3350Laka Got). It is beautiful walk through mixed forests of deodar, oak and rhododendron. Triund is situated on a ridge with a beautiful view of whole Kangra valley

on one side and Dhauladhar mountain range on the other. Laka Got is situated at the snout of a small glacier is the base camp for the shepherds. The small glacier is called snow-line.

▲ Inderhara Pass Trek: - A combination of 3 treks, Mcloedganj-Triund (2975m), Lahes Caves (3700m) and Inderhara Pass (4300m). The trek goes through mixed forest of oak, rhododendron and deodar trees. It is a flat meadow on top of a ridge. Next trek is an acclimatization day and after short ascent from Triund traverse a ridge to reach Laka Got – a temporary shepherd camp. Laka Got is situated at the snout of a small glacier, which is full of snow and ice in early summer and the snow melts away during the monsoon. From Laka Got it is a steep ascent for 2 km over a rocky ridge to reach Lahes Cave. Start early in the morning at Inderhara Pass, the weather gets bad in the afternoon. In the early summer (April to May) the trail is full of snow and ice and require good equipment.



▲ Dhauladhars Round Trek: - Dhauladhars Round trek is 7 days trek and cover Kareri Village (2200m), Kareri Lake (3500m), Rawa Village (2100m) and Guna Devi (2975m). The Trek goes through the pine forest and crosses several tribal villages on the way. First 2km is a level walk and then there is steep ascent along Kareri Nullah (stream) which has to be crossed over a number of times over improvised wooden bridges.

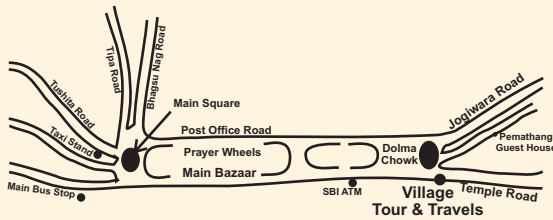
